






Breakdown Sale Volumes by Countries (MWh)




Breakdown Sale Revenue from electricity by Countries (mTHB)



Key Financial Highlights





12M2019 vs 12M2020

- 30.3% growth of Revenue
 - + New COD projects (Rooftop in Mar-Apr and Yamaga in June).
 - + Full period of revenue recognition from Vietnam and Mongolia projects.
- Gross profit grew by 19.6%, at lower rate than revenue growth due to increase of depreciation and amortization as well as O&M cost of new COD projects.
- Net Profit grew at 34.9% in line with the increase of revenue.
- Core Operating Profit grew at 13.6% to reach 696.2 mTHB.
- Gain from unrealized fx is 39.9 mTHB in 2020, whereas loss from unrealized fx in 2019 is 66.7 mTHB.

12M2019 vs 12M2020


- Gross profit margin reduced from 67.7% to 64.2% due to narrower margin of new COD projects but still at favorable rate.
- EBITDA margin increased from higher depreciation.
- Core operating profit margin decrease from 41.3% in 2019 to 36.0%, mainly due to lower solar irradiation.


Total Asset





Hidaka 17.0 MW: Operation performance
















